Prescription Assistance Program

The Program: Hearts That Care Prescription Assistance Program provides \$30 a month credit at certain local pharmacies to help with prescription co-pay costs for individuals who meet the program criteria below, who apply and have been approved for the program.

- 1. The funds cannot be used for controlled drugs.
- 2. Any unused funds will not rollover to the next month.
- 3. The patient is responsible for any cost over \$30 per month.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE: (Month to month vouchers)

- 1. Individuals cannot be a patient at Hearts That Care Volunteer Health Clinic medical clinic. One exception: They can be a patient at Hearts That Care's dental clinic and have health-only insurance.
- 2. Those with Incomes at or below 133% of Federal Poverty guidelines. Tax return or letter of IRS required for documentation.
- 3. Must have valid ID
- 4. Have a current medical insurance card or SoonerCare (Medicaid) member number.

OTHERS ELIGIBLE (Single month voucher)

- 1. Those living in Homeless shelters without access to financial documentation. A local shelter can fill out and sign a Shelter Referral form. The shelter has to fill one out each month for the individual. The individual has to submit the letter to the Clinic.
- 2. **Those in a crisis situation:** Area mental health clinics, churches/other non-profits can refer individuals using a Mental Health & NonProfit Referral form.

APPLICATIONS

- 1. Individuals meeting the criteria above can call Hearts That Care clinic, 580-354-9007, and leave a message to set up an appointment to submit an application.
- 2. Homeless shelters or non-profits working with people in crisis can call the clinic at 580-354-9007 for a clinic representative to brief your staff and provide forms to help your clients.
